The complete outline of the second C mintmark is seen to the right of the S.

Comments : The complete outline of the second C mintmark shows. The first mintmark should be under the S; there are no signs of the C within the S. Repunching of the S mintmark seen. CherryPicker's lists a second S/CC variety, but the C appears way too small and this is more likely a die scratch. Al lists 2 different S/CC varieties, listed as 6, 7, 7.1.






Comments : How many among us check Trade dollars for MPDs? The top of this digit is very bold and the gap between the denticles are very deep. You would expect to see more digits. This could be explained if the date punch was tilted to the right. There were many trade dollar obverse dies used, yet there are no examples if digits in the main devices. If a date alignment jig and template was used, we should see a few examples of these as all other silver and copper denominations are smaller.
