Comments : There is a large increase in the number of doubled dies found on the 1963 Franklin Half Dollars to the 1964 Kennedy Half Dollars. A prime factor is likely that in 1963 approximately 25 million half dollars were struck, in 1964, this was increased to 277 million. This 11 fold increase would have obviously required many more working dies to be produced, increasing the probability of more mistakes in the hubbing press.

This also leads to the conclusion that the doubled working hub was the result of a partial hubbing whereas only the profile was hubbed first.
